We are looking for farm businesses that would like to be involved with an Action Network group and are interested in the following areas:

- Developing farm business plans, including long-term goals and objectives, key areas for improvements, and practical means of achieving these.
- Assessing industry benchmarking data, developing KPI's, and understanding correlations between on-farm investment and profitability.
- Assessing return on investments for inputs into pasture and crop production.
- Assessing variations in nutritional requirements and stock performance across stock classes.
- Gaining a greater understanding of the likely impacts of environmental regulations and consumer demands moving into the future.

What is Action Network?

RMPP Action Network provides farmers with:

- Facilitated, supported and structured small groups of farm businesses working together to achieve change on their farm (7-9 farm businesses).
- Trained and supported facilitators to guide their group and help identify expertise.
- Tools and resources to support their group.
- A network of experts who can share new knowledge and ideas.
- Kick start funding of \$4000 per farm business which is pooled for the group to bring in expertise and pay for facilitators.
- The knowledge that RMPP Action Network is built on research and international best practice.
